INSTRUCTIONS:

RESTRAINING OCCUPANT & OPERATING BELTS:

ENSURE BUCKLE ENGAGEMENT. .. ATTACH ICS BELT TONGUES INTO ICS UPPER BELT BUCKLES WITHIN SEAT BACK PILLOW HEAD REST. TUG BELT STRAPS TO

 LOCATE THE ICS BELT RETRACTOR TONGUES IN ICS BELT TONGUE STORAGE POCKET, THEN FULLY EXTEND BELTS UPWARD CENTER OCCUPANT BETWEEN ICS BELTS & LOWER ICS BUCKLE

ICS BELT TONGUE STORAGE POCKET-

ICS FLOATING TONGUES:

SEAT BACK PILLOW HEAD REST

ICS BELT RETRACTOR (TONGUE)-

ICS UPPER BELT BUCKLE-

RETRACTOR BELT-

NOTE: BELTS AT FULL EXTENSION WILL ENGAGE THE SECONDARY LOCKING FEATURE.

THE ICS BELTS WILL RETRACT TO FIT SNUGLY ON OCCUPANT. A PATCHET NOISE IS AUDIBLE WHEN BELTS

WHEN IN USE AND KEEPS OCCUPANT SECURED. NOTE: THE BELTS WILL ONLY RETRACT AND NOT EXTEND WHEN ENGAGED IN USE. THIS PREVENT SEXTENSION

SECURE LOWER RESTRAINT BELT BUCKLE TO ICS FREE FLOATING TONGUES CONNECT CHEST CUPS TO ONE ANOTHER AND LOCATE ACROSS CHEST JUST BELOW ARM PIT LEVEL CHECK THAT OCCUPANT IS RESTRAINED WITH BELT HARNESS FITTING SNUG.

REMOVING RESTRAINED OCCUPANT AND STOWING BELTS

DISENGAGE LOWER RESTRAINT BELT BUCKLE FROM ICS FLOATING TONGUES.
 DISCONNECT CHEST CLIPS AND REMOVE OCCUPANT.
 TO STOW ICS BELTS, START AT SEAT BACK HEAD REST TO DISENGAGE ICS BELT TONGUES FROM ICS UPPER


BELT BUCKLES

 PLACE ICS BELT TONGUES INTO ICS BELT TONGUE STORAGE POCKET & PLACE ICS LOWER RESTRAINT BUCKLE 4. FULLY RETRACT EACH ICS BELT TOWARD THE SEAT BITE

NOTE: IF NEXT OCCUPANT REQUIRES ICS BELT HARNESS, BELTS DO NOT HAVE TO BE STOWED. INTO SEAT BITE. (SEE ILL #2)
