The Toyota Green Grand Prix partners with Watkins Glen International Speedway and the Sports Car Club of America, hosting an annual event for the past 14 years. Our primary sponsors are Upstate NY Toyota Dealers Association and the Doris Bovee Memorial Foundation. The focus is on auto-tech students, innovators, and general public, drawing participation from high schools, colleges, and individuals from N.Y. and several surrounding states. This year's event will be held Friday, April 5.

The annual Toyota Green Grand Prix features a challenging fuel economy contest run at 45mph on the hilly WGI NASCAR short track as well as an autocross for EVs, plug-ins, and hybrids.

Also included are tours of the track in alternate fuel buses, demonstrations, and educational talks in the WGI Media Center. All our events are free and open to the public.

We expect 150+ High school and University technology students from approximately nine high schools and colleges. The public is encouraged to come and enjoy the events at no charge.
