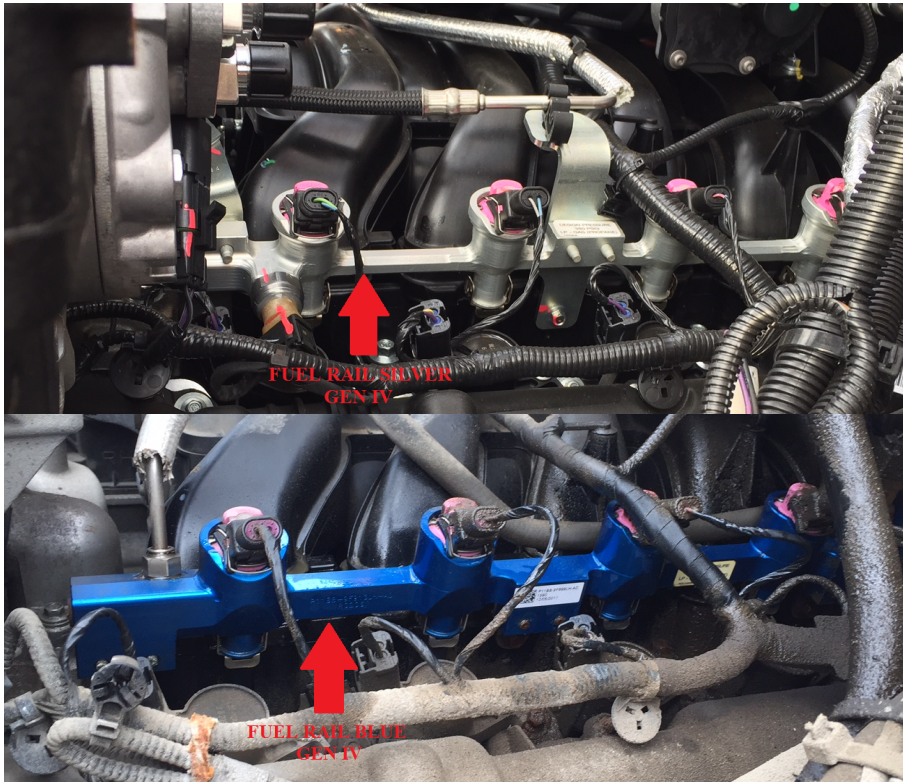


Roush GEN III and GEN IV Differences

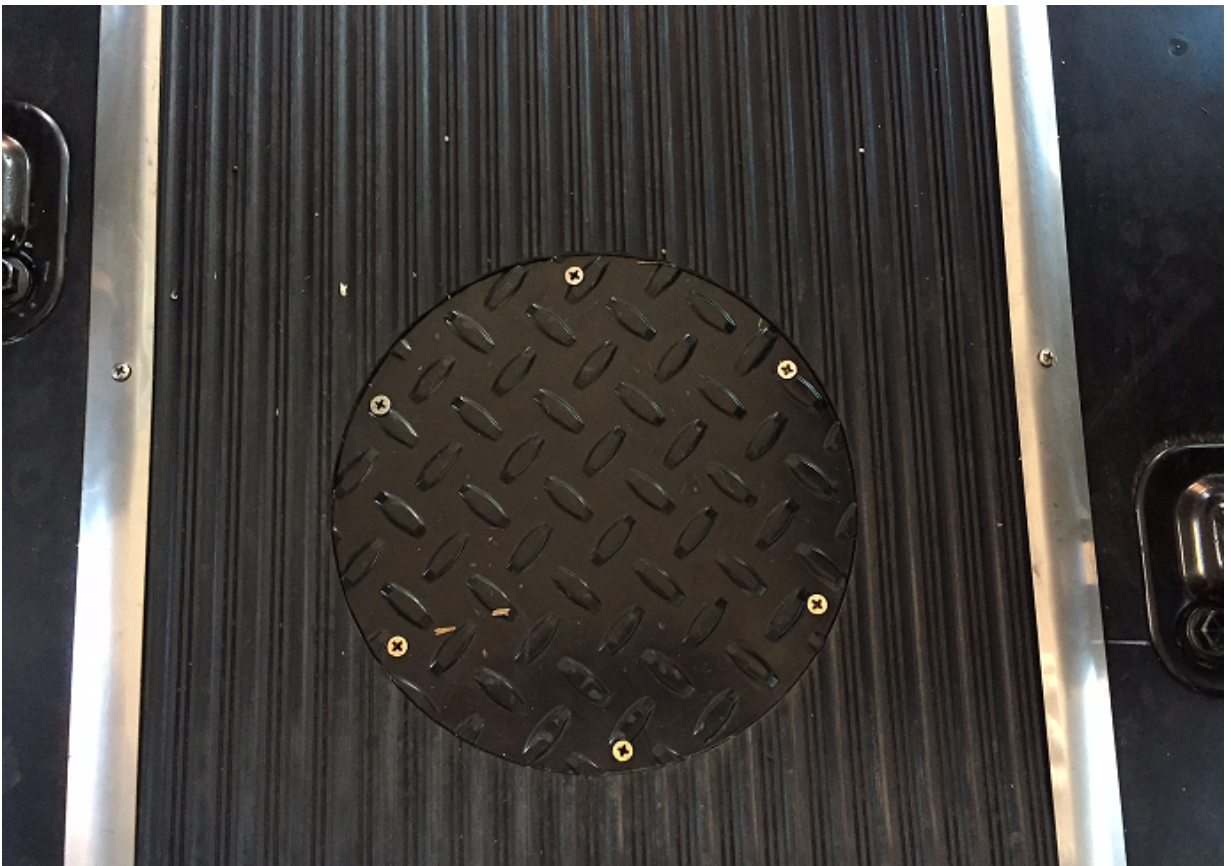


Identifying the Roush GEN III and GEN IV Systems

We have had recent questions on how to tell if a unit has the Roush GEN III or GEN IV system.

It is very easy and just requires popping the hood – The GEN IV system has **SILVER** fuel rails as in the top photo where the GEN III has **BLUE** fuel rails as in the lower photo.

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UPDATE FEBRUARY 27, 2017-

You can also distinguish between the two by the presence of a fuel sender access plate located in the center aisle toward the rear of the unit as shown in the photo above. If the unit has this access plate then the Roush System is a GEN IV.

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
