Product Affected-Blue Bird's New D3 All-American and New Vision

Complaint - The dash illumination will not work with the panel light adjustment.

Cause - With the new dash cluster the "dimming" affect of the dash cluster is

adjusted through the scroll keys of the cluster itself as seen in Figure #1

Correction - Follow the steps below to adjust the cluster illumination and the panel

illumination

PLEASE NOTE – Your parking brake should be released to perform this function, parked with your foot firmly on the brake pedal.

Step #1 – Locate the 2 buttons at the right lower corner of the cluster as shown in Figure #1

Button #1-Scroll Down

Button #2-Scroll Up

Step #2 – With your headlights on, press button #1 and the dash will go to the darkest setting showing only the MPH light as in Figure #2.



Step #3 – With your headlights still on, press button #2 and the dash will progressively illuminate along with the LCD screen as shown in figure #3.

PLEASE NOTE – The other lights of the panel, Left Controls and Shifter are still adjusted using the panel dimmer located under the headlight switch on the left side of the dash as shown in Figure #4.
