Product Effected – New D3 All American and Vision with the Updated Driver's Compartment

Complaint - The ignition key is different!

- We ordered "Keyed Alike" and it does not fit our other units.
- We took the key to our local person who makes keys and they did not have a blank to cut

Cause -

Blue Bird Listened! we had heard that the previous ignition key was sometimes cumbersome to use especially on those cold dark mornings and we took those concerns to Blue Bird who incorporated a new ignition switch into the updated steering column used in the new D3 and when they redesigned the driver's cockpit in the Vision – This key slides easily in and out of the ignition switch and will work in either "direction" so to speak. Both switches are shown in Figure #1.

The unfortunate part is that it is change and the new style cannot be used in previous models nor can the previous style cannot be used in the new model.

We have actually taken both to a locksmith to see if tumblers could be changed but they are different also-

Correction -

Moving forward you will have the new easier to use switch and keys in your units -

To deal with the issue of blanks, we stock part #10012568 which is the key blank for the new switch. You can also use a "Club" key blank which I'm told is common and that is a #CLB8 and should be available where you have keys cut or your local locksmith
