

BBCV Front ABS Sensor Wiring on Air Brake Units

Complaint – The ABS light is on and we have checked the sensors and tone rings and everything seems to be good-

Cause – The sensor wire has become "chaffed" through at fitting near the brake chamber. As you can see in Figure #1 it appears that the sensor wire is nicely tied up, which it is. Upon further inspection as you can see in Figure #2, the crimped fitting has worn into the sensor wire as shown in Figure #3 causing it to ground against the metal thus throwing the ABS light!

Correction – Removing the ties and installing wire loom over the sensor wire and then putting the wire tie closet to the end of the hose back on the rubber part of the hose about ½" as in Figure #4 will not allow the metal to chaff into the wire. As added protection you could also wrap electrical tape around the hose where the metal end is crimped on.
