

BBCV/Cummins Front Exhaust "FOIL" Wrap

Complaint -

There is a tear (Photo #1) in the outer layer of the "foil" insulation....and if let go long enough can allow the insulation to start to come out (Photo #2)

Cause –

There could be several causes, but the shear fact that the pipe runs down close to the front tires where road debris is "kicked" up from the tires lends to the abuse this pipe gets. We have also seen that in some cases it is the way in (direction) in which the tape is wrapped around the pipe and attention should be paid when replacing so that the forward edge is not the "open" end of the wrap.

Correction -

Clean all oil/grease debris from the surface of the area which is damaged and completely dry. Then wrap the affected area with the foil wrap tape wrapping at least twice at the beginning wrap and the end warp to ensure good adhesion.

PLEASE NOTE – IF A PIPE IS NOT FOUND TO HAVE THIS ISSUE UNTIL IT LOOKS LIKE THE PHOTO IN PHOTO #3 THEN THE PIPE WILL NEED TO BE REPLACED!
