

Microbird G5 Rear Destination Sign Bulbs

Complaint – The lights are blown for the rear destination sign – How do you change them?

Cause – While most of our applications where illuminated "School Bus" signs are used

there is a "door" to access the lights – the $G5\ does\ not$

Correction – Please follow the steps below to gain access to change the bulbs-



Locate the padded header over the rear entrance door

Locate the 2 "buttons" and remove them which will access 2 phillipshead screws – shown at left



Once the screws are removed you will need to pull slightly at each corner as there are Velcro strips at each corner also – remove pad as shown at left



Once the pad is removed, bending down and looking to the inner side of the rear panel you can see the 4 light sockets



Reaching in through the 2 openings you can access the 4 sockets and change the bulbs



We recommend changing ALL 4 bulbs
