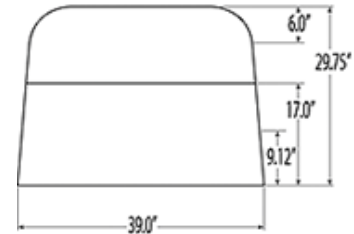
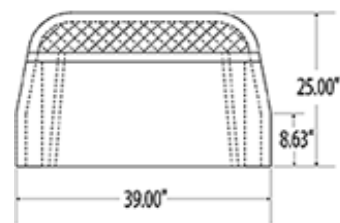




## PARTS UPDATE – Seat Foam Shortage

### SEAT FOAM SUPPLY CHAIN DISRUPTION

Recently we were made aware of issues impacting production of seat foam products. A chemical shortage is resulting in supply chain disruptions impacting foam plants that support furniture, bedding and seat manufactures. Our leading supplier has indicated that the prime/virgin foam will be the first product line to be impacted. Rebond foam will continue to be available however the timing of how long that continues to be available ultimately is dictated by the shortage.

New York Bus Sales will try and monitor these issues while attempting to increase stocking levels as well as alternate vendors to fill current orders.
