Blue Bird Type C & D with Actia Dash Cluster

Complaint – In the LCD display of the dash there is a new box next to the voltage which reads “undA” – See Figure #1

Cause – We do NOT order units normally with the Ammeter setting on the dash and if for some reason it becomes enabled in the cluster settings then this will display on the dash

Correction – Reset the dash setting for Ammeter Display to “DISABLED”

Follow the following instructions-

- With the unit parked, parking brake set and ignition off press the 2 buttons at the right lower corner (Figure #2) and turn the key to the on position.....this will bring up the Configuration menu (Figure #3)
- Using the lower button, scroll down until you see the “AMMETER DISPLAY” – If it shows “ENABLED” (Figure #4) you know that is the issue
- Once highlighted, you can press both buttons at the same time and it will change to “DISABLED” (Figure #5)
- Now just turn the ignition off and then turn ignition back on and that box should now be gone (Figure #6)

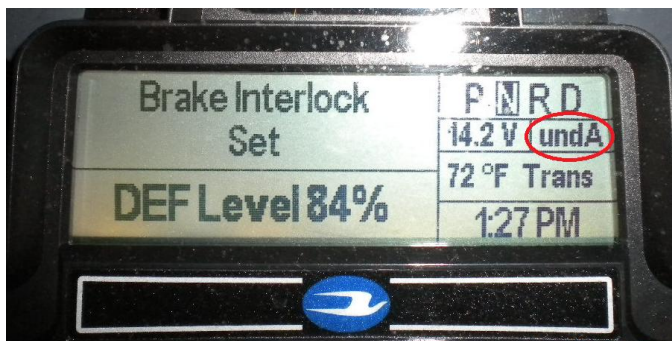

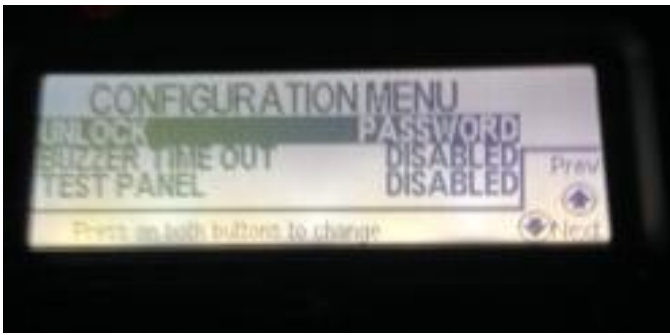

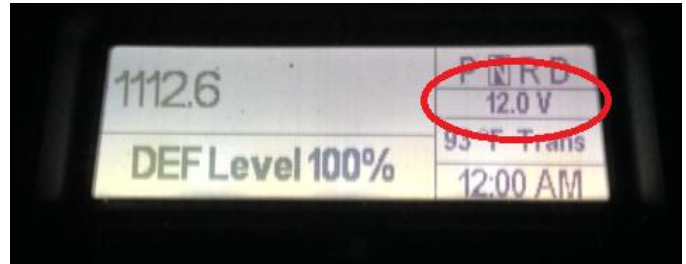
