T3FE Steering Column Boot Clamp

- Complaint –** Steering seems to have a slight “catch” in it when turning from lock to lock
- Cause –** The “boots” on the lower section of the shaft have a clamp installed which does not allow the steering shaft to turn smoothly and the boot in some cases will rip as the clamp is holding it too tight to the shaft.
- Correction –** Removing the clamp (Shown with the arrows in Figures #1 & #2) will allow the shaft to move unrestricted and without any “catching”

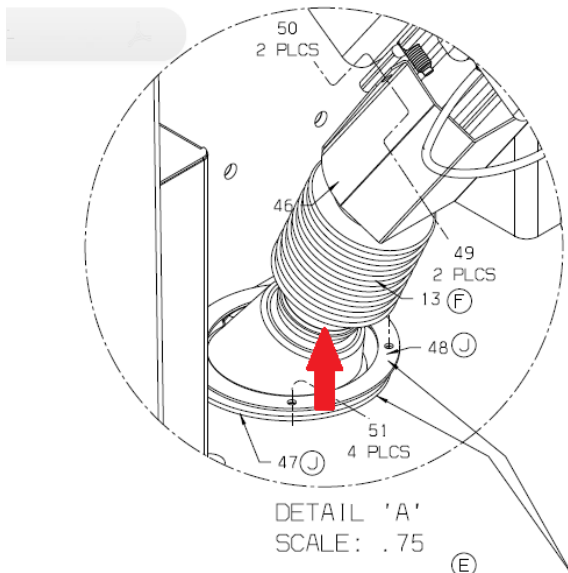
