

BBCV/T3FE-RE Emergency Windows

Complaint – The emergency window "drops" when it is opened and you have to raise it when shutting to get the latch to catch.

Cause – There is a "shim" on the hinge side (Figures #1 & #2) of the window frame at the lower corner which holds the window up when opened. If that shim is missing or broken the window will drop when opened, and then when it is closed it is out of alignment and will not latch unless slightly lifted.

Correction – Replace the broken or missing shim with rivet included with the shim (Figure #4)








