

Blue Bird BBCV-Vision

Complaint – With the inclement weather the lower glass of the entrance door becomes "coated" with grime and impairs the driver's vision out the door.

Cause – Seeing as the right front tire is just ahead of the door, especially in a left turn, it is literally throwing the debris around and just pulling up slowly or pulling away with the door open causes the door to be "coated" with the debris.

Correction – New York Bus Sales has made a bracket and found a mudflap which when installed follows the contour of the fender and comes out further so as to keep road debris from being thrown down the side of the bus and more importantly on the entrance door.
