Product Effected -All American "D3"

Complaint: Driver's are complaining of cold air in the driver's area.

Cause: There is a "Fresh Air Vent" located in the driver's compartment

which may be open.

Correction: Quick check is to open the left wiper door (Figure #1) and look

directly above and behind the power steering reservoir (Figure #2)

to see if the vent is open.

If it is found to be open there is a vent lever just to the left of the steering column just in under dash (Figures # 3 & #4) which

operates the vent.


